## The excursion will be organized on June 29 (Wednesday), 2022 from 9.00 to 20.00.

We plan to visit archaeological site <u>Viminacium</u>. Viminacium was the capital of the Roman province Moesia Superior and a legionary fort, set at the right bank of the river Danube, about 100 km east of Belgrade. Besides that, it is one of the few ancient Roman cities that is preserved outside the modern agglomeration and is still a sight of active excavations and research (see <u>Viminacium virtual tour</u>).



We will also visit the fortress of Smederevo, which is set at today's outskirts of the modern town Smederevo, at the confluence of the rivers Jazava and Danube. The fortress was built in the 15<sup>th</sup> century, by Serbian despot Djuradj Branković, modeled after the palisades of Constantinopol and it was the last capital of the medieval Serbia.



The route that we are going to take will be along the Danube river valley, which is, since ancient Roman time, known for growing grapes and wineproducing. We will use this oportunity to visit winery Jeremić, for wine-tasting and snacks.

We will have lunch with lovely view of the Danube river, in the restaurant Jugovo in Smederevo which cherishes the tradition of domestic Serbian cuisine.
