CONFERENCE: XXIII Geometrical Seminar

August 30 – September 5, 2026, Zlatibor, Serbia

This is the 23rd meeting in the series of Geometrical Seminar meetings, which started its activities during the eighties in the last century, under the name Yugoslav Geometrical Seminar. At the beginning, the seminar was on the national level. The aim of these meetings is to bring together mathematicians and physicists interested in geometry and related fields, and its applications, to give lectures on new results, exchange ideas, problems and conjectures.

Conference fee: The regular conference fee is 250 Euro (early bird registration 200 Euro), 120 Euro for students and accompanying persons (early bird registration 100 Euro) and the conference fee for the online participation is 50% of the regular fee. All fees include VAT. The payment instructions can be found on the site.

- Accommodation booking: July 1, 2026
