History. This is the 23rd meeting in the series of Geometrical Seminar meetings, which began its activities during the eighties in the last century under the name Yugoslav Geometrical Seminar. At the beginning, the seminar was of the national level. The aim of these meetings is to bring together mathematicians and physicists interested in geometry and related fields, and its applications, to give lectures on new results, exchange ideas, problems, and conjectures. We are planning to organize the conference in both regimes: in person and online.

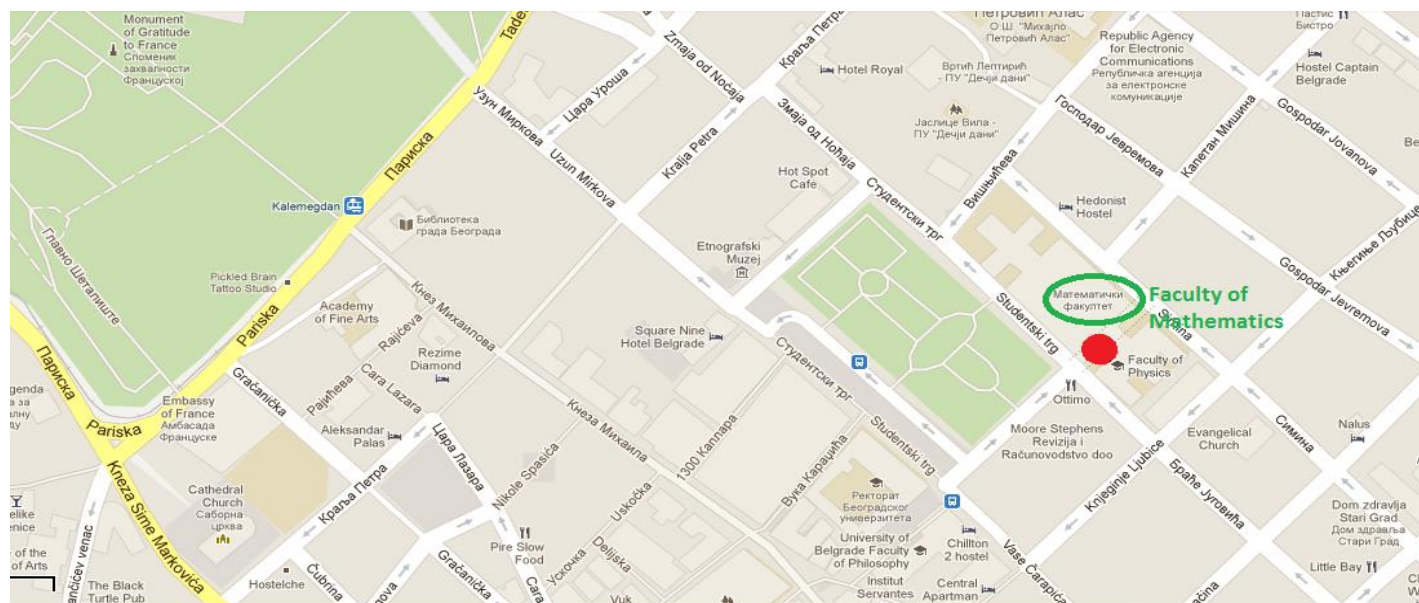
